### Study: By the Numbers (2016)

- 550,000 startups <u>each month</u>
- Demographics:
  - 60% White

6% Asian

• 20% Latino

- 4% Other
- 9% African-American

- 60% headed by Men
- 40% headed by Women

- Interesting Facts:
  - Most only stay open one year or less
  - African-American women are fasting growing demographic

- Know What What is entrepreneurship?
- Know How How to start a venture...
- Few share: (Middleton and Babson, 2013)
- Know Why what happens when you learn what it takes for you to engage in the process
  - Why do this?
  - Why am I doing this?
  - Why should I continue doing this?
  - Personal Sense-Making!

Courses in Know What and Know How
 DO NOT positively impact increases the
 entrepreneurial endeavors of people of color.

- I collaborate with many of each of these.

## HOW CAN WE INCREASE THE NUMBER OF TECH FOUNDERS OF COLOR?

- Original Study
  - 1. Juxtopia Urban Innovation and Cooperative Entrepreneurship (JUICE<sup>TM</sup>) Program (18)
  - 2. TEDCO Minority Business Pre-Seed Fund (Pilot), specifically with its first few round of winners(6)
- Both in the Maryland
- NOTE: I am a participant in both programs.

- Why Tech Entrepreneurship?
  - 1. "I don't want to have to work for anyone."
    - "I'm smart, I want to try my idea."
  - 2. "To make more money."
  - 3. "I don't want to be stuck making other people a bunch of money, who don't even appreciate me."
    - "I'm smart, I want to try my idea."

- To Venture or Not To Venture:
  - Just want to make product, try idea
  - Not sure of venture capital (VC)
    - What it is... What it entails... If it is desired...
  - Satisfied with producing and selling
    - Perhaps this is the extent of entrepreneurial knowledge
  - Too many (more) hurdles when going for VC
    - <u>NOTE</u>: This is becoming a Tech Founder!
    - (PRIOR) **EVALUATION** of Valuation, Marketing, Sales, Team, Business Model, Ability to Scale, and so on...

- SUPPORT-SYSTEM IS EXTREMELY IMPORTANT!
- ...WHETHER YOU SEEK VC OR NOT!

#### **BECAUSE (KNOW WHY):**

- Form Identity
- Establish Legitimacy
- Ponder & Develop Attitudes and Values
- Develop Personally and Socially
- Learn from Context
- GRIT? Persistence?
- Passion? ...is it enough?

- Women are:
  - Selected most often\*
  - Follow through most often
  - Have most (progression) successes
- Next Steps:
  - Share more qualitative data/stories
  - Understand the above on a larger scale and why!

  - Men
  - Women
  - Both
  - White Males?
- National Survey
  - Everyone!
  - ...With as much qualitative characteristics as possible
